

C. PERSONNEL

ORIENTATION, CONTINUING EDUCATION, AND IN-SERVICE

The Board of Education recognizes the importance of continuing education in maintaining the skills of the professional staff. The Board further recognizes that certain beneficial programs are offered during school time.

Therefore, the Board shall allow groups of teachers and/or principals, with the approval of the Superintendent, to meet on school time for in-service training, provided such activity does not cause undue interference in the instructional programs of the school(s) involved.

The Board will provide for orientation sessions for new teachers and the opportunity for teachers to visit other classrooms when the principal and the staff of the Superintendent approve such activities.

As finances permit, the Board shall budget for materials and consultative services used in the training programs.
