

FUNDRAISING/ SOLICITATIONS

SOLICITATIONS IN THE SCHOOLS

There shall be no public solicitations, charity appeals, or fund raising activities by outside organizations carried on within the school system among either employees or students unless given permission in writing from the Superintendent or the Superintendent's designee. If permission is granted, the solicitations can only be done before or after school hours. Under **no circumstances can any solicitation be made on school time**, e.g. during lunch, planning periods, etc.

FUNDRAISING/SOLICITATIONS BY STUDENTS

The principal must approve all fundraising activities in advance. Principals must obtain the permission of the appropriate Assistant Superintendent before any fund raising project can be conducted in Raleigh County Schools

Activities, which are scheduled for the purpose of fund raising should not take place during the instructional day, except on rare occasions when the Principal feels it cannot be facilitated at other times. Students shall not be involved in door-to-door selling of fund raising merchandise and donation tickets for drawings.

All funds should be handled as directed in Raleigh County Policy 3.5, "School Financial Management".
