Re: Masks for Students in Raleigh County Schools

Masks will be required for All Students k-12 in Raleigh County Schools.

Masks must be worn on buses at ALL TIMES. (SEE exceptions)

EXCEPTIONS TO THIS REQUIREMENT:

- Students with medical reasons that have been identified by health care provider,
- If a child becomes ill and the mask must be removed OR
- If a disability manifests itself to endanger the student or impede educational progress.
- **Physical Education Class:** When outside participating in rigorous activity and social distancing can be maintained. This applies to recess as well. (Note* masks must be worn when students are transitioning to and from physical education as well as recess).
- **Pre K students:** WILL NOT BE REQUIRED but encouraged to wear masks. Masks will be introduced to Pre-K students during different settings within their class to help attain our goal of being good ambassadors of GOOD HEALTH PRACTICES teaching children to protect themselves and others.
