- Regular school attendance is required by law and is essential to your child's educational success
- To avoid an unexcused absence your child must turn in an excuse within 48 hours of their return to school. Excuses that are accepted are:
 - ◆ Doctor's excuses
 - ◆ Parent Note (5 each semester)
 - ◆ Special circumstances will be considered
- 3 unexcused absences will result in a written notice sent by the attendance department
- 5 unexcused absences will result in a legal notice and a mandatory meeting with the school
- 10 unexcused absences is the maximum allowed for the school year and will result in legal action
- It is possible that your child will be conferenced at school by the Attendance Department.
- Driving privileges revoked when a student accumulates 15 unexcused absences or 10 consecutive unexcused absences. Students may have 5 home excuses per semester. Doctor excuse or parent note must be submitted within 48 hours of returning to school. Half days will be counted towards driving privileges. Suspension days are counted as unexcused.
