

SPECIAL BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING

October 25, 2018

ROLL CALL – The Raleigh County Board of Education met in special session on Thursday, October 25, 2018 at 5:30 PM at Hollywood Elementary School with the following members present: President Larry D. Ford, Vice-President Charlotte Hutchens, Ms. Marie Hamrick, Ms. Marsha Smith, and Mr. C. David Price, Secretary. Mr. Jack G. Roop was absent.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA – President Ford called the meeting to order. Dr. Hutchens moved to approve the agenda. Ms. Hamrick seconded the motion. The motion passed 4-0.

OPENING REMARKS — President Ford welcomed everyone to the meeting. Superintendent Price recognized Cranberry-Prosperity Elementary School as receiving Lighthouse School status through the Leader in Me Program. Cranberry is the 3rd school in the state to earn this title and 375th in the nation.

NEW BUSINESS

- The principal/chairperson of each school introduced their LSIC members and confirmed the presence of a quorum. Each principal then briefly reviewed the Executive Summaries and responded to questions from board members. Elementary schools presenting were: Cranberry-Prosperity, Crescent, Maxwell Hill, Bradley, Mabscott, and Hollywood.
- President Ford presented the 4th Place Campus Beautification Award to Maxwell Hill Elementary and Third Place to Bradley Elementary.
