



Which report do I use?

Report	Result
Diagnostic	Individual skills assessment, grade equivalent, percentile rank, and the amount of time student spent taking the test. Each student's report prints on a separate page.
Growth Report*	Are students meeting growth expectations for the current year only.
Instructional Planning	Which students should be grouped together for targeted instruction and practice
Screening Report	View students who are reaching benchmark and which need intervention
Student Instructional Planning	What are students ready to learn next
Student Progress Monitoring*	Is the student responding to the intervention
Summary Report	Students' results that include name, class, the type of test taken, teacher, test date, rank, Scaled Score (SS), Grade Equivalent (GE), Grade Placement (GP), Percentile Rank (PR), Normal Curve Equivalent (NCE). The reading report includes Instructional Reading Level (IRL), Estimated Oral Reading Fluency (ORF), and Zone of Proximal Development (ZPD).

*Must have data from two tests. Use after Benchmark 2.
